**JOIN THE FIGHTBACK DAY 2026:** Join the Fightback Day 2026 – The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (SPUC) will be holding a *Join the Fightback Day* this weekend. SPUC exists to radically transform culture so that abortion is not only abolished but becomes truly unthinkable. But recently Parliament removed legal consequences for a woman aborting her own baby – at any stage, for any reason. Self-induced abortion up to birth is now permitted in England and Wales. If you are shocked by this, you are not alone. Abortion extremists have gone too far, and we must not let this stand. Join us now in the fightback to bring an end to this barbarity. Show your support by joining SPUC's campaign to defend unborn babies and their mothers. **SPUC:** The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children will be holding a **Tiny Feet Coffee and Cake Sale**, with a Celebration of Life Exhibition, in Our Lady of Victories Catholic Church, 1 Fairfield Road, Market Harborough, LE16 9QQ, on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July**, from 10.00am until 4.00pm. All are very welcome.

**ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL:** Kim Leadbeater's assisted suicide Bill failed in April after it ran out of time in the House of Lords. This means it did not become law. However, assisted suicide campaigners are [now trying](#) to bring the Bill back in this new parliamentary session. A number of MPs who voted for the Bill last year have been drawn in the Private Members' Bill ballot, and they are now coming under pressure to use their slots to revive the Bill. The Disability Rights Group *Not Dead Yet UK* has [launched a new tool](#): <https://action.notdeadyetuk.org/> that enables people to email their MP explaining why bringing back the Leadbeater Bill would put people with disabilities at serious risk. Even if you have already contacted your MP about why the Bill should not be revived, it is important that you write again using this new tool. MPs need to hear clearly that many disabled people and disability rights campaigners are deeply concerned about the dangers this Bill would pose. When you enter your postcode, you will then be asked to provide your details, and you will see a draft email that you can make changes to before sending it to your MP. When you hit send, this email will be sent to your MP along with a physical postcard to their Parliament address (you can see what that postcard looks like on the sheets provided in the Porch) - both will include the contact details you have provided, so it is clear to your MP that the message has come from a real local constituent. Disabled people and others at greater risk of pressure or harm need the support to live, not a law that exposes them to greater danger. This Bill does the opposite - it facilitates premature death and puts people at risk. **We must stop this dangerous Bill from returning. Take action today - your message could make all the difference.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND: Day for Life.** The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England and Wales, *Day for Life* is celebrated on the third Sunday of June each year. This year it falls on Sunday, 21 June.

### **THEME OF THE READINGS:**

A new phase in the long process of relations between human beings and God begins on Sinai: the choice and constitution of a people by God. With Jesus Christ a new people of God was established in history, founded on the Twelve: "Jesus summoned his twelve disciples.... These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon...." The new people of God was constituted through the total offering of Jesus Christ on the Cross through which the Father reconciled us to him: "through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have already gained our reconciliation" (DICASTERY NOTES, 1999).
